### Weekly Review

Please note, if you have reviewed our Calls for Services, you'll see the Weekly Review doesn't include a comprehensive list of calls to which LPD responded. Incidents included here are based on severity, impact on public safety or other factors.

- A catalytic converter was reported stolen from 21XXX Keswick Loop.
- A Traffic Stop, on Pilot Knob Road, resulted in the DWI arrest of a 35-year-old male. He tested a .22 BAC before being jailed.
- Vandalism/Property Damage was reported at Aronson Park.
- A 33-year-old male was taken into custody after assaulting another male at Antler's Park. The suspect was jailed for 5<sup>th</sup> Degree Domestic Assault and Tamper with Motor Vehicle.
- Property Damage was reported at 17XXX Firestone Path after an unknown driver struck three mailboxes.
- Property Damage was reported at 9XXX 217<sup>th</sup> Street West after unknown persons pried entry into the victim's vehicle.
- Theft was reported from 16XXX Hyland Avenue. Golf clubs and a push golf cart were stolen from an open garage.
- Property Damage was reported at 17XXX Junelle Path. A brake line was cut on a bicycle and a nail was stuck in the tire.
- Harassment was reported at 16XXX Innsbrook Drive. The suspect has repeatedly called and sent harassing emails.
- Fraud Activity reported after the victim sent compromising photos to an unknown suspect who is now threatening to leak the photos unless the victim agrees to pay the suspect not to.
- Fraud Activity was reported by a victim who attempted to purchase event tickets via Facebook. Money was sent to the unknown suspect, but the tickets were never provided.
- A separate Fraud Activity was reported by a victim who attempted to purchase a puppy through a website. After paying over \$6k in fees for the dog, it never arrived.
