Weekly Review

Please note, if you have reviewed our Calls for Services, you'll see the Weekly Review doesn't include a comprehensive list of calls to which LPD responded. Incidents included here are based on severity, impact on public safety or other factors.

- Officers were dispatched to 20XXX Iberia Avenue on a Suspicious Activity report. An unknown 52-year-old male was taking unwanted pictures and making lewd comments at the pool. The suspect was GOA, but his cell phone was left behind. The investigation is ongoing.
- Theft of a vehicle was reported from 18XXX Inlet Road. A short time later, the vehicle was found in Cass County by a Deputy. It had been involved in a single-vehicle rollover. It was unoccupied upon arrival.
- Theft of copper wire was reported from a home under construction at 17XXX Giants Way.
- Theft was reported from a home at 7XXX 167th Court West after several hundred dollars of cash went missing.
- Patrol responded to a two-vehicle Hit & Run Traffic Accident. A suspect plate was obtained, and the vehicle was located. A 19-year-old male was cited.
- A bicycle was reported stolen from 20XXX India Avenue.
- Patrol responded to another Vehicle Theft, this time at 16XXX Kennard Court. An unknown party entered an open garage door and stolen the vehicle inside. A short distance away, officers located a stolen vehicle from Rosemount. It had been abandoned after being involved in multiple burglaries, including the theft of several firearms.
- Officers responded to a Burglary Report at 2XXX Cleopatra Drive. The victim returned home to find an unknown male and an unknown female inside the residence. When confronted, they allegedly threatened him with a knife and fled. Several thousand dollars of cash was stolen.

- Officers were dispatched to a Driving Complaint. Several callers reported an SUV, with heavy front-end damage, driving erratically throughout the southeast part of town. Eventually, a homeowner at 21XXX Hytrail Circle, reported a vehicle in the backyard. The 40-year-old female driver appeared highly intoxicated. She ultimately provided a .38 BAC and was transported for medical care. Officers later located two suspected accident sites, one at Kenwood Trail and Jaguar Avenue, where the vehicle struck a light pole and street sign. And another at 202nd and Holyoke, where the vehicle traveled up and over the roundabout, leaving parts behind and damaging several trees.
- A Theft of cash was reported at 17XXX Kenwood Trail. Approximately \$800 was stolen from a purse.
- Patrol responded to a Traffic Accident at Hummingbird Avenue and 175th Street West. The at-fault driver appears to have fallen asleep behind the wheel, colliding head-on with the other vehicle. Fortunately, human injuries appeared mild. Sadly, there was a dog that didn't survive the collision.
- Patrol responded to a Theft report at 10XXX 202nd Street West. The victim was having work done on the home when a worker abruptly left. The victim noticed a debit card and ID were missing. Subsequently, over \$2400 was spent on the account. The investigation is ongoing.
- A catalytic converter was reported stolen from 16XXX Hutchinson Drive.
- Vandalism/Property Damage was reported at 17XXX Inland Circle. The victim woke up to find a tire on his car was slashed and the street was spray painted.
- A Traffic Stop, at Kenwood Trail and Jordan Trail, found the driver with a loaded Glock in the backseat. The 25-year-old male was arrested for Possession Without a Permit.
- Patrol documented a Theft of an aftermarket stereo from a vehicle parked at 17XXX Kenwood Trail.
- Patrol responded to a Burglary report at 8XXX 205th Street West. The investigation is ongoing.
- Patrol responded to a Theft in Progress at 17XXX Kenrick Avenue. The suspect stole \$60, but was GOA.
- A Traffic Stop, at Kenrick Avenue and 195th Street West, resulted in the 4th Degree DWI arrest of a 26-year-old female. She failed SFST's and tested a .13 BAC.
