### Weekly Review

Please note, if you have reviewed our Calls for Services, you'll see the Weekly Review doesn't include a comprehensive list of calls to which LPD responded. Incidents included here are based on severity, impact on public safety or other factors.

- Patrol responded to a Burglary at 16XXX Houston Avenue. The homeowner advised the garage door was left open overnight. An unknown suspect(s) stole a drill and a bicycle.
- Vandalism/Property Damage was reported at 17XXX Kenrick Avenue. The victim's vehicle sustained scratches.
- Patrol responded to a Burglary at 16XXX Griffon Trail. A set of custom golf clubs and a golf bag, total value \$3,300.00, were taken from an open garage.
- Burglary was reported at 20XXX Keokuk Avenue. An unknown suspect(s) gained entry and stole a cash drawer.
- A bicycle was reported stolen from 17XXX Kenyon Avenue.
- A Traffic Stop led to the arrest of a 19-year-old male. During the stop, the vehicle came to an abrupt halt on Orchard Trail and the driver fled on foot. During an inventory of the vehicle, the suspect's phone and wallet (containing information with his new address) was found. Officers made contact and he was jailed on several charges.
- Motor Vehicle Theft was reported at 17XXX Jubilee Way after a rental car was stolen. A short time later, the vehicle was recovered crashed in Minneapolis.
- Two catalytic converters were stolen off of vehicles at 21XXX Holyoke Avenue.
- Theft was reported from 16XXX Interlachen Boulevard. A leaf blower was stolen from an open garage.
- Vandalism/Property Damage was reported at 19XXX Holyoke Avenue. A window was broken out.
- Patrol responded to a Theft in Progress at 17XXX Kenrick Avenue. An unknown male walked behind the counter and stole cash from the register.
- Patrol responded to a car vs. bicycle Traffic Accident at Dodd Boulevard and Hayes Avenue. It was determined the bicyclist failed to yield to traffic and ran into the vehicle's passenger side. Luckily, the bicyclist only sustained a few minor scrapes.

- A 40-year-old female was arrested for 5<sup>th</sup> Degree Domestic Assault.
- Officers were dispatched to 19XXX Itea Avenue on a Burglary in Progress. The homeowner had gone outside after hearing the car alarm go off. Two unknown subjects were observed carrying a subwoofer box to their vehicle. The investigation is ongoing.
- Theft was reported at 7XXX 170<sup>th</sup> Street West after a diamond ring was found to be missing.
- Theft from Vehicle was reported at Steve Michaud Park. A wallet, containing credit cards, was taken.
- Officers located a slumper passed out in his vehicle at 185<sup>th</sup> Street West and Kenrick Avenue. Unfortunately for him, the 23-year-old male passed out before he could conceal his narcotics usage. Evidence was still lying in his lap. He was woken and detained without incident for 5<sup>th</sup> Degree Possession.
- Theft was reported from a storage unit at 21XXX Heron Way. The lock was cut off and contents were stolen.
- Officers responded to a Welfare Check at 21XXX Kenrick Avenue. A 30-year-old male was found passed out behind the wheel of his vehicle. He was impaired and admitted to using meth. During a car search, a loaded handgun was found. Turns out, the suspect is also a convicted felon adding Gun Possession to his DUI charge.
- Officers responded to Burnsville to assist in searching for a suspect who fled on foot from a weapons-related Assault call. With assistance from K-9 Kilo, LPD Officers located the suspect hiding in the woods and took him into custody without incident. The suspect was turned over to our BPD partners.
- Responding to several Driving Complaints, Officers arrested a 20-year-old male driver, at I35 and 210<sup>th</sup> Street West, for DWI. He failed SFST's and tested a .14 BAC.
- Officers were dispatched to 17XXX Kenwood Trail for Theft in Progress. A male suspect fled in his vehicle before the officer's arrival. An employee had obtained a license plate. Responding the suspect's address, the vehicle was located, with the stolen merchandise visible inside. It was returned to the store and the 28-year-old male was cited for Theft.
