Weekly Review

Please note, if you have reviewed our Calls for Services, you'll see the Weekly Review doesn't include a comprehensive list of calls to which LPD responded. Incidents included here are based on severity, impact on public safety or other factors.

- Responding to a Welfare Check, Officers located a 38-year-old male passed out behind the wheel at 20XXX Holyoke Avenue. He tested a .25 BAC and was jailed for DWI.
- Vandalism/Property Damage was reported to a vehicle at 8XXX 166th Street West.
- Patrol responded to a Driving Complaint and located the driver at I-35 NB and 162nd Street West. The 22-year-old male driver was cited for Reckless Driving, Speeding, and Failure to Yield to Emergency Vehicle.
- Patrol arrested a 32-year-old male for an OFP Violation.
- Fraud was reported at 7XXX 160th Street West, after counterfeit bills were passed.
- Patrol responded to 17XXX Kenwood Trail on a report of a young adult male exposing himself. The incident is being investigated.
- A Traffic Stop, at Granada Avenue and Gooseberry Way, resulted in the DWI arrest of a 49-year-old male. He failed SFST's and tested a .25 BAC.
- Theft was reported from 9XXX 217th Street West after 100 pallets were stolen.
- Officers responded to 5XXX 170th Street West on a Suspicious Activity report. Contact was made with the 30-year-old male who attempted to run. He was apprehended and jailed on multiple warrants and a ticket for Fleeing.
- A 28-year-old male was cited for 5th Degree Assault.
- Officers responded to a Traffic Accident at 7XXX 160th Street West. The at-fault driver alleged his brakes went out, causing him to rear-end vehicles stopped in traffic. Three victims were transported to the hospital with injuries.
- Theft of a mail package was reported at 8XXX 210th Street West.
- Theft and Fraud Activity was reported by a victim who had checks stolen from a mailbox. Checks were fraudulently written against the account. The investigation is ongoing.

- Officers and LFD responded to a House Fire at 17XXX Inland Circle. The house was fully engulfed upon arrival. The homeowners and their pets were able to make it out safely. LFD extinguished the flames, but the home sustained significant damage.
- Vandalism/Property Damage was reported to a home and vehicle at 21XXX Ixonia Lane.
- Officers arrested a 51-year-old male for 5th Degree Domestic Assault.
- Patrol responded to a Domestic/Disputes in Progress and issued a KOPS Alert for a 22-year-old male for Domestic Assault.
- Vandalism/Property Damage was reported to a vehicle at 17XXX Huntington Path.
- A bicycle was reported stolen from 175th Street West and Iberia Avenue.
- Responding to a Driving Complaint, Patrol arrested a 53-year-old male for 4th Degree DWI. He failed SFST's and tested a .12 BAC.
- Patrol responded to a Suspicious Activity report at 18XXX Kenyon Avenue. The reporting party advised his Ring camera picked up motion near his vehicle. He then observed an unknown female enter his vehicle. When the victim went to approach the female, she fled.
- Patrol responded to a Traffic Accident at 11XXX 185th Street West. One driver, a 62-year-old female, ran the light. That same driver, and her passenger, were transported to the hospital with minor to moderate injuries and was cited accordingly.
- Theft from Vehicle was reported at 7XXX 210th Street West. Two money orders, totaling \$920.00, were taken.
- Officers responded to a Driving Complaint and located the 22-year-old male driver at Juliet Drive and Shakespeare Boulevard. He was found to be impaired and arrested for DWI after testing a .13 BAC.
- Patrol responded to 18XXX Dodd Boulevard for a Vehicle Fire. Lakeville Fire quickly extinguished the fire. Fortunately, no injuries were reported.
- Officers responded to a Traffic Accident at Dodd Boulevard and Hayes Avenue. The suspect vehicle was EB on Dodd, at Highview, and struck a yield sign, one-way sign, and went up over the roundabout causing a lost tire. The 34-year-old male driver appeared impaired, failed SFST's and was jailed for 3rd Degree DWI after he tested a .16 BAC.
