### Weekly Review

Please note, if you have reviewed our Calls for Services, you'll see the Weekly Review doesn't include a comprehensive list of calls to which LPD responded. Incidents included here are based on severity, impact on public safety or other factors.

- Vandalism/Property Damage was reported near Lakeville Boulevard and Cedar Avenue. A motorist had an unknown object thrown at the windshield causing damage. No suspect information was available.
- Vandalism/Property Damage was reported to a vehicle at 17XXX Layton Path.
- Patrol documented a two-vehicle crash at Kenwood and Jaguar Avenue. The at-fault driver attempted to make an illegal U-turn and got rear-ended.
- Officers were dispatched to a Driving Complaint at 162<sup>nd</sup> Street West and Buck Hill Road. The 911 caller reported being aggressively followed by a white Honda SUV that had struck him. While trying to evade the suspect vehicle, the victim's car was struck several more times. Upon officers arrival, the suspect was nowhere to be found. A conversation revealed a Domestic issue and the suspect as known to the victim. A KOPS alert was issued for the 22-year-old male suspect for two counts of 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree Domestic Assault.
- Fraud Activity was reported after an unknown person made over \$240k in fraudulent charges on a victim's credit card
- Theft from Vehicle was reported at 7XXX 160<sup>th</sup> Street.
- Officers arrested a 34-year-old female for DWI after she struck a parked motorcyclist at 21XXX Glade Avenue. Fortunately, the victim didn't have any serious injuries. The suspect tested a .26 BAC and was jailed on 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree DWI.
- Officers responded to a fully engulfed vehicle Fire at 7XXX 175<sup>th</sup> Street West. The vehicle was a complete loss and, fortunately, the occupants all escaped uninjured.
- Traffic Stop, at Cedar Avenue and 200<sup>th</sup> Street West, found the 49-year-old male driver impaired. He failed SFST's and tested a .25 BAC. He was jailed on several charges, including DWI.
- Our partners at Burnsville PD assisted on a Traffic Accident at 162<sup>nd</sup> Street West and Buck Hill Road. One victim sustained several injuries and was transported to the

hospital for care. The 30-year-old male at-fault driver was found to be intoxicated, failing SFST's, and testing a .16 BAC. He was jailed for numerous charges, including DWI.

- Officers responded to a 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree Assault and 1<sup>st</sup> Degree Burglary at 20XXX Holiday Avenue. A 23-year-old male forced his way into the residence and assaulted another 23-year-old male. The physical encounter involved a knife, and the victim sustained a cut to the leg. A KOPS alert was issued for the suspect.
- Burglary was reported at 17XXX Hollybrook Trail. The victim reported leaving the garage door open overnight. The next morning a wallet was missing.
- Fraud was reported at 20XXX Icenic Trail. A 40-year-old male opened a bank account and deposited some corporate checks. \$5k was then withdrawn from the account, but the checks later came back rejected. The bank demanded the money back. The victim alleges he met a woman online who directed him to make the transaction in exchange for gift cards.
- Two vehicles were involved in a Traffic Accident at 16XXX Joplin Avenue. Both vehicles were unoccupied upon Patrol arrival. The suspect vehicle struck a parked car on Joplin Avenue, rolled, and came to a rest in the middle of the road on its roof. The possible owner of the vehicle was uncooperative and denied involvement. There were no witnesses and both vehicles were towed.
- Responding to a Driving Complaint, Patrol arrested a 25-year-old male driver for 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree DWI at 16XXX Jackdaw Path. He tested a .24 BAC and was jailed.
- A purse was accidentally left in a shopping cart at 20XXX Keokuk Avenue. Upon realizing it and returning, the purse was nowhere to be found. The purse contained a bank card, identification, a checkbook, an iPhone, and several thousand dollars cash.
