Lakeville Parks and Recreation strives to make your experience as safe and fun as possible.

Please take a few moments to read through a series of procedures as noted below. The procedures outlined cover the majority of the programs offered, however, specific policies may be outlined for some programs in a welcome letter you would receive prior to the start of the program.

Masks- For those not vaccinated, face masks are strongly recommended.

Hand sanitation – Practicing good hand hygiene helps everyone stay healthy. It is recommended that participants sanitize hands before and after attending a program.

Illness and Exposure – A participant may not participate in Lakeville Parks & Recreation programs if they are exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19 until they receive a negative COVID-19 test or have completed the recommended CDC guidelines on how long to stay home.
